

# COVID Safety Protocols & Requirements for the February 6, 2022 Event

*In order to participate in the 2022 race, you must provide proof of vaccination or proof of a negative COVID test administered within 72 hours of the race. There are several ways to provide proof, which are detailed below.*

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR VACCINATED PERSONS

- 1. Vaccinated persons are invited to upload digital proof of vaccination via a third party platform called Bindle.** Bindle allows you to securely store your COVID-19 test and vaccine records and easily prove your health status prior to race day. Please note that bindle respects the fundamental right to privacy and will never share your personal health information.
- 2. Bib mailing is available for vaccinated persons ONLY and is strongly recommended.** To opt-in to bib mailing, participants must add-on bib mailing for a \$20 fee. The deadline to add-on bib mailing and upload your proof of vaccination is January 9th.
- 3. If you register after the bib mailing deadline has passed or do not opt in for bib mailing, you will be invited to upload vaccination status in Bindle in mid January.**
- 4. If a participant does not wish to upload their vaccination record to Bindle, they may provide proof of vaccination in-person and pick up their bib at one of our bib pick up locations** on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, or Saturday of race week. Bib mailing is only available for vaccinated persons who opt to upload their vaccination status via Bindle.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR UNVACCINATED PERSONS

- 1. Unvaccinated persons must provide proof of a negative test result taken within 72 hours of race day** (no earlier than Thursday, February 3rd) with appropriate turnaround time to attend one of our in-person pick up events on Thursday, Friday, or Saturday prior to the race. You will be invited to upload digital proof of a negative test via a third party platform called Bindle.
- 2. Test types accepted are Molecular/PCR test results for COVID-19 on a sample collected within 72 hours of entering.** Self-administered rapid tests will not be accepted.
- 3. Unvaccinated persons are not eligible for bib mailing** and must attend one of our in-person packet pick-up events to provide proof of a negative test and pick up their bib.

## Additional COVID protocol information to note:

- Bib pick up and vaccination or negative test result verifications WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE on race morning.
- Masks will be required on board our official race shuttle buses.
- Participants are strongly recommended to wear masks in the start area.
- Disposable masks will be available within the finish festival for those who would like one.
- Disposable masks will also be available at all medical tents.
